Partner: The Association for the rescue of the Brekov castle is concerned with the conservation of the Brekov Castle, Renovating some of its parts and generally saving it. Besides this, they are involved in collecting information about the Brekov castle, guide activities (from archives, literature, inhabitants), fundraising, provide information to the wide public and organizing cultural events connected to the castle. Workcamps are organized on Brekov castle since 2009.

Work: Reconstruction works in the area of an ancient ruins of the castle – "Brekov" from the 13th century. It will involve manual masonry works. Cleaning environmental works will be also part of the work. The volunteers will learn the old techniques of masonry.

Accommodation & Food: Lodging will be provided in the tents in the area of the castle; in case of bad weather lodging will be provided in the village Brekov. Food will be provided by local volunteers.

Location and leisure: Brekov is a village near Humenne in the Presov Region of north-east Slovakia. The ruins of the Brekov castle are located on the hill above the village and are in good shape. Brekov Castle was built around 650 AD by the Slavonic nations. The area offers several possibilities for hiking or visiting several ruins of the castle.

Terminal: Airport, bus, train in Bratislava, Kosice; then train or bus to Humenne. Volunteers will be picked up in Humenne and transported by local partner directly to Brekov. Please keep in mind that the journey from Bratislava to Presov takes for app. 8 hours. ISL 06 SERIOUS FUN WITH SENIORS IN BARLICKA PRESOV 28/07/2013 – 10/08/2013 ELDE

Partner: Association Barlicka (Little crutch) has been working with young people with physical disabilities since 1999. Barlicka created a centre for helping its clients to live independently and it has been offering activities of daily social centre, practical school, courses (theatre, dance, music, PC, etc.) as well as centre for mothers. Services for elderly people in centre were added in 2011. The workcamp is organized in Barlicka centre for the first time.

Work: The volunteers will organize free time activities for elderly clients of NGO Barlicka. The activities for clients will be organized during the daily summer camp for the clients – summer activities, little trips, competitions, games. The volunteers will use the activities of non-formal education and will create activities about ecology.

Accommodation & Food: Lodging will be provided directly in the centre of the NGO Barlicka on beds. Sleeping bag is needed. Volunteers will be in charge of preparing the food. Vegetarian catering is possible.

Location and Leisure: the camp will be organized directly in city of Presov – the 3rd biggest city in Slovakia on the East part. The volunteers could enjoy old historical centre, castles around Presov and the cultural life in the city.

Terminal: Airport – Vienna, Bratislava, Kosice; then train or bus to Presov. Please keep in mind that the journey from Bratislava to Presov takes up to 7 hours. ISL 11 STONE TOWER KAMENICA, PRESOV 23/07/2013 - 31/07/2013 RENO/ARCH

Partner: The Association Kamenna Veza (Stone Tower) was founded in 2006 and its aim is the preservation, recovery and study of culture of Kamenica castle especially on a regional level. The association is trying to make the castle accessible to wide public and also to youth volunteers and has been organizing international workcamps since 2010.

Work: Help with archaeological research and revitalizing the old ruins of the Kamenica Castle from first half of 13th Century: cleaning the place from vegetation, storing and sorting of stones and help with the georadar research. The volunteers will help also in the workcamp kitchen.

Accommodation & Food: The Kamenica Castle is situated on the west slopes of Cerhov Mountains. However it is 1 km far from the civilization so there is no electricity, no water-supply and no public transport. Lodging will be provided in tents on airbeds on a wooded floor - warm sleeping bag and mat are needed. Common soldier tent, field kitchen, dry toilet, solar showers and drinking water will be provided. Meal will be prepared by the volunteers themselves (breakfast and dinners), it is necessary to bring own plate, cup and cutlery. The lunch will be provided from the local caterer. Vegetarian catering is possible.

Location and Leisure activity: The castle is located between Kamenica and Lucka-Potoky. They are villages near Presov (35 km far away) located in the Eastern part of Slovakia. From Kamenica (1,5 km) or Lucka-Potoky (1 km) you can get by feet to the ruins of the Kamenica Castle – the place of the workcamp. The volunteers will have several possibilities for hiking, visiting castles in the region.

Terminal: Airport – Bratislava, Kosice; then train or bus to Presov continuing to Lipany and than bus going to Lucka-Potoky or Kamenica. Please keep in mind that the journey from Bratislava to Presov takes for app. 6 hours. So please plan your journey to Bratislava with arrive in the morning.

Remarks: Bring sleeping bag and mat, working clothes and gloves, warm clothes, raincoat, strong boots, swimming suit, bowl, spoon and a smile on your lips :)

ALLIO9 Camp Piispala Kannonkoski 21.7-3.8. RENO vols: 12 age: 18+

W: The work is mainly maintenance work, it is done in the area of youth centre Piispala and mainly outdoors. The tasks during the work camp includes cleaning the environment, small renovation/freshening up -tasks in buildings or in the area, gardening/planting etc. Piispala is one of a network of ten national youth centres in Finland. One of the main goals of Piispala is to maintain the development of the local, national and international youth work and to serve as a multi-sided centre of sports activities and education. The

centre is well equipped for practicing various kinds of sports and handcrafts. A: Accommodation will be in rooms or cottages. Meals will be arranged by Piispala: the camp participants have the possibility to eat breakfast, lunch and dinner buffet in Piispala canteen. Evening snacks / necessaries for evening snacks will also be provided.

L: Piispala is situated in northern Central Finland, 7km from the village of Kannonkoski. In Kannonkoski there are 1 600 inhabitants. The nearest towns are Saarijarvi and Viitasaari (with about 8 000 inhabitants), both about 40 km from Piispala. The nearest bigger city is Jyvaskyla, 105 km from Piispala. W: The aim of the camp is to organize playing activities for children at a local large playground and perform puppet theatre shows for them. UNAS09 Treharris Youth 20th July- 3rd August

Location: Treharris Region: Rhonddha Cynon Taff

KIDS Summer activities for young people aged 11-25

Nearest train station: Quaker's Yard Train Station

Work: International volunteers will be hosted by the Treharris Boys and Girls Club. The Club has been an important community centre for many years. Volunteers will support youth workers and local volunteers to run summer activities for young people in Treharris. The young people may be aged between 11 and 25 but most will be under 18 years old. Activities will be based on several themes: art and culture, physical activity, information and advice, healthy living and citizenship. Volunteers should come with ideas about activities they could run on these themes and be prepared to plan events for the young people. The playscheme will run from 12 – 4pm each day and volunteers will also be required to spend approximately 2 hours planning and evaluating activities.

The workcamp will also involve an international cultural event open to all members of the community on Friday 2nd August. This will celebrate the work that the volunteers have done and volunteers will help to plan and organise the day.

Accommodation: Volunteers will be sleeping in dormitories in the Treharris Boys and Girls Club building. There are bunkbeds, showers and clothes washing facilities and bedding is provided. Volunteers will use the kitchen in the building to cook together and everyone will be expected to take part in cooking and cleaning as part of group life.

Location: Volunteers will be living in the centre of Treharris, a small town in the

Rhondda Valley. The Rhondda Valley was once at the heart of the Welsh coal mining industry and there is still a strong industrial heritage in the area. The region has suffered with the decline of industry and again with the recent economic crisis and unemployment is high, especially for young people. However, the towns in the Rhondda remain strong communities with a reputation for being very welcoming.

Treharris is approximately forty minutes from Cardiff by train and is close to the town of Merthyr Tydfil. There are a number of museums and attractions in the area, especially ones that record the industrial heritage of the region. Treharris is also close to the Brecon Beacons National Park.

Special Requirements: Certificate of Good Conduct; Motivation Letter – specific to this project; good spoken English.

CONCUK08 MABLETHORPE 2

27.07 – 11.08 Kids

Location: Lincolnshire, England Requirements: CGC

This project offers volunteers the opportunity to join the longstanding success of the Leicester Children's Holiday Centre schemes for underprivileged children. Each year the centre enables up to 500 children (aged 7-11 years from inner city areas) to enjoy one week of an activity filled summer holiday by the sea.

Work: The international volunteers will support the work of the paid staff at the centre. Work will involve supervising a set programme of indoor and outdoor activities such as sports, games and crafts and generally helping the children enjoy their summer holiday. Volunteers must be prepared to join in the activities that the children enjoy - and do not get the opportunity to do at home - such as shopping, beach games, team building activities. This project involves long hours and hard work but it is very rewarding.

Accommodation: In shared rooms with either beds or mattresses on the floor. All bed linen is provided and up to 3 volunteers will be sharing a room. All facilities provided. Meals will be taken with the children and provided by catering staff. Alcohol and smoking are strictly forbidden on the premises, although an outside area is provided for smoking.

Since it is always nice to try new and different dishes, volunteers are encouraged to bring along their favourite recipes from home!

Location: The centre is situated in the sand hills of Mablethorpe, a small typical North Eastern seaside town on the Lincolnshire coast complete with fun fairs, souvenir shops and amusement arcades. Mablethorpe is quite isolated with limited transport and no rail connection; so volunteers must enjoy seaside life.

IBG 13 Hoetensleben 19/07/2013 10/08/2013

PROJECT: The main project will be to maintain the site of an open-air-museum and memorial of the Iron Curtain. The village of Hoetensleben was situated directly on the eastern side of the German-German border when Germany was divided during the period of the cold war. An association called "Grenzdenkmalverein" was founded after the fall of the Iron Curtain which maintained four hundred meters of the former frontier protections system as a kind of open-air-museum. Visitors can still experience the different walls and electric fences, the watchtowers and iron barriers and get an impression of the violence of this monument.

WORK: Volunteers will work on the upkeep of this monument. The concrete tasks might include clearing the former path used by border guards to patrol the border from vegetation, painting the lorry barriers, and restore the wall and fences. The workcamp includes several study-parts on this period of the German history with several excursions and activities together with local people. During the camp period there will also be a huge rock festival in the village, you might be asked to give a hand during the set up and the disassembly of the stage and the preparation of the festival ground.

ACCOMMODATION: in the former village hall, different sleeping rooms. Beds will be provided.

LOCATION: Hoetensleben is a little village with approx. 2.500 inhabitants. International workcamps have been invited for some 13 years, so local inhabitants are looking forward to welcome the volunteers and many activities will be done together with local associations e.g. the voluntary fire brigade of Hoetensleben. Volunteers should be interested in a close contact with the German population and in German history. Therefore, volunteers should add a short motivation letter describing their interest in this special project.

Project: The workcamp will take place in Tvarozna Lhota, a small village in the White Carpathian Mountains. Here "INEX-SDA White Carpathian Mountains" supports rural development and the education towards a sustainable way of life. It offers educational free-time activities to young people and operates an ecological open-air centre called "Cottage Travicna" with an ethnographical exposition on life in the mountains. The organization also supports the production and consumption of regional goods, such as herbal teas, goat cheese, lamb meat and many more.

Work: Most of the work will take place at the ecological areal "Cottage Travicna". During the first week the volunteers will help with manual work, such as easy-to-handle landscaping and reparations of fences and play structures for children. Other tasks will include setting up fences for the extension of the number of domestic animals bred in the centre, maintenance of the surrounding area (repairing tourist trails, taking care of an arboretum of local woods, a herbal garden and a little orchard of traditional fruits). During the second week, volunteers will help to prepare the event "Ethnosalas" (a celebration for local children). During the celebration, volunteers will assist in implementing different activities for children. If the weather conditions allow, volunteers will also collect herbs in the surrounding meadows and in the nearby forest, herbs which will be used for the production of organic teas.

Study part: A guided excursion to the biosphere reserve "NPR Certoryje", a guided tour along the nature-trail "Oskeruse" (traditional regional fruit), a trip to the Bata Canal and sustainable tourism are planned. Learn more about local products, organic farming, the history and natural potential of the region. An international cooking evening with the local youth and workshops on pottery and batik with traditional colours are planned. The program includes a trip to Bratislava (Slovakia).

Leisure time: Trips to various sights of the regional cities of Straznice, Uherske Hradiste and Skalice plus a daily afternoon-program, including games and trips to the close-by countryside and sights will be offered.

Accommodation/Food: The volunteers will be accommodated in a building in

the very centre of the village. You will need to bring your own sleeping bag and sleeping mat. Two small bathrooms are available. Please be prepared for basic living conditions as the house is very small. The volunteers will prepare their meals together – a small kitchen is available in the living area. Bring your national recipes.

Location: Tvarozna Lhota (bus stop in the village, next train stop Straznice). The nearby bigger cities are Straznice (5 km distance) and Uherske Hradiste (30 km). The region is famous for its folk traditions and beautiful countryside. Note: This project is realized with the support of Johnson Controls.

SDA 207 Contemporary art in Chateau Trebesice II 28/07 – 18/08 RENO/ART

5 places

Project: The project is organized by FUTURA, one of the leading Czech NGOs active in promoting contemporary arts and fostering a dialogue between artists and the general public. FUTURA runs following activities: a large centre for contemporary art in Prague where exhibitions are held; a Prague complex with 4 art galleries, 17 artists' studios and an archive of Czech contemporary artists; a residency program for international artists in Prague and recently also in New York. Apart from that, FUTURA also operates in a Renaissance chateau Trebesice with beautiful, traditionally managed gardens which is being converted into a unique centre of contemporary art containing both indoor and outdoor artistic installations and which hosts many artists each year.

Work: The workcamp will take place in the Chateau Trebesice and in the surrounding grounds. The work will be manual and will be focused on two main spheres of activities: gardening and heritage. The gardening part will include different tasks such as lawn cutting, care for trees, plants, flowers, fruits and vegetables, watering, etc. The heritage part will include the renovation of the Granary, an amazing 4-story building from XVIII century which will be converted into a gallery of contemporary art to host and display FUTURA's growing collection. Volunteers will use some traditional techniques during the renovation works.

Study part: Apart from gaining new gardening and renovation skills, volunteers will have the opportunity to discover Czech and international contemporary art both in the Trebesice Chateau and in FUTURA's galleries and other art and cultural institutions in Prague and in Kutna Hora (a UNESCO site).

Leisure time: There will be many possibilities of how to spend free time. Volunteers can take part in Italian cuisine lessons where locally grown products will be used, they can have a football match with a local team from the village of Třebešice where the chateau is situated, they can go swimming in Kutna Hora's water reservoir or Kolin sand quarry. Also, they can practise jogging and biking.

Accommodation/Food: Volunteers will live in a self-contained, simple apartment in the grounds of the chateau with a sleeping room (with bunk beds), a kitchen and a bathroom with basin, shower and toilet. Please take your own sleeping bag. Shopping and cooking will be a common activity, fruit and vegetables grown in the gardens will be available for volunteers. Once a week, one of FUTURA's founders, who is also an amazing chef, will cook with the volunteers a special dinner or lunch, and will share with them his gastronomic secrets and recipes.

Location: Chateau Trebesice in the small village of Trebesice, 80 km from Prague and 5 km from Kutna Hora. Today there are more than 80 artworks displayed inside and outside the Chateau and the other historical outbuildings and the complex is open to the public.

Note: Previous experience with gardening and/or construction work is of course welcome but not strictly required. Good physical shape, a positive liking of manual work, an open and friendly attitude towards working and living in a collective, interest in the arts and knowledge of English language are required.

OH-W06 Lohra Castle ENVI/RENO 11.08. - 29.08.2013

Lohra Castle is situated in the heart of Germany in Northern Thuringia. The castle, which is surrounded by a scenic hilly landscape, is located on the edge of a nature reserve area. Being one of the largest castles in Thuringia, the history of the castle Lohra begins in the Middle Ages. The castle is more than 1000 years old. Today, it includes 20 buildings from different times: medieval fortifications, remnants of a tower from the 11th century, a roman chapel, a manor from the Renaissance period as well as stables and granaries from the 19th century.

The ensemble is situated in the centre of a beautiful forest. For years Lohra

Castle was vacant. At the beginning of the 1990s Open Houses started to restore the castle and to revive it by cultural activities at the beginning of the 1990s.

Project Descriptions

All projects of Open Houses are based on a sustainable principle. Also on Lohra castle the work will be balanced between natural and cultural fundamental ideas. On one hand the volunteers will repair and restore the castle buildings and on the other hand there will be works to be done in the green area around the property.

Open Houses attaches great importance to renewable energy. The heating system on the castle is based on solar power and wood fired heating. Under this aspect the volunteers will collect and cut firewood from the forests nearby, which they find on the ground.

The volunteers will also bring the wood from the forest to the castle. Therefore they need to load up the wood to a truck and unload it on the castle to store it under a roofed place for wintertime. The branches will be used to build traditional fences.

The natural environment around the castle is listed as National Nature Heritage and Open Houses supports this idea by cleaning the forest with the activity of the volunteer groups.

Also the volunteers will prune of the paths of weeds and small trees, to keep them accessible not only for utility vehicles, but also for hikers and walker in the nature reserved woods.

Another important task for these campgroups is to transport building material. As parts of the castle are only accessible by foot the volunteers will help to transport manually material from and to the building site.

The volunteers will also continue the cultivation of the green areas around the castle.

Oberau is a small village located only four kilometres away from Meißen which is nearby Dresden. Woods and several ponds in walking distance are characteristic for the countryside around the castle. The castle itself is build on an island between two ponds and is surrounded by a farmhouse.

Oberau Castle dates back to the Middle Ages but was converted in the 16th century. The ensemble of buildings includes a castle from the renaissance with a park, a manor-house from the classical age and several barns. Despite many changes undergone in the process, there remains the cross vault on the ground floor and in the upper floors many painted wooden ceilings from the renaissance and the baroque period.

Project Description

The camp at Oberau Castle will do small renovation works in a youth accommodation house in the castle complex and will lay out a fireplace for campfire. Furthermore the volunteers will bring the castle site and its outbuildings back to a proper appearance, removing building materials and cleaning the whole area. The group will load up the material to a truck which will bring the things to other houses of Open Houses. Furthermore the group will take care of the green areas, mow the lawn, cutting wood and cleaning the surrounding castle moat.

With regard to the small distance to Dresden and Meißen the volunteers will have the opportunity to visit important monuments and historical sites in their leisure time. The capital of Saxony fascinates its visitors with its magnificent baroque architecture and there are way more spots of interest. At Meißen it is worthwhile visiting the gothic chathedral which is well known as one of the best examples of gothic architecture. The close by old Albrechtsburg castle which offers a wonderful view over the river Elbe is also the place to visit the famous porcelain manufactory of Meißen.
