building on the man made lake in Ingolstadt together with a youth organization there, the Ingolstadt Stadtjugendring. Since thn, it has been used as a youth educational house for children and youth work, as well as a green classroom. Under the expert leadership of experienced craftsmen, your team will be renovating three old huts on the outer grounds, put a new roof on them, and the paint them. These will be used as storage space for materials use by the youth organizations here. Your team will also build a bread oven out of bricks and put a roof on it. Accommodation: You will be sleeping on cots in shared tents (4-6 people per tent) on the grounds of the Youth Educational House near the lake, about 2 km away from the city center. A kitchen and sanitary facilities are on hand. Catering: It will be a mix of preparing your own meals (breakfast and dinner) and catered food (lunch at the construction site)

Location: Bavaria; Regensburg 75 km, Munich 80 kmFree Time: The city of Ingolstadt is located on the Danube River and offers many historical sights for sightseeing. The old city center is marked by its churches, castles, and houses. There are also museums and a zoo. You can go for a swim in the lake located right at your accommodation, or visit the pool at the Fronte 79 Youth Center, located 2 km away. Description: With five other municipalities, Saint-Lager and its 400 local wine producers defend both the quality of their wines but also their built and natural heritage. Description: Emmaus is a association that welcomes marginalised and homeless people, mostly men. They are called companions. The Neuilly Plaisance community (50 companions) with a place where they can live and work. It is a place where people live together in a spirit of solidarity. Some companions live there temporarily while going trough a tough phase in life and the community supports them towards social reinsertion; others see life in the community as an alternative way of life. There are 3 founding principles in all Emmaus Communities: welcoming people (everybody whatever their origin and their past); reinsertion by working (collecting, rehabilitation and sale of furniture, clothing, diverse objects...); sharing and solidarity in the community. The work will consist into helping the community in the everyday tasks such as: sorting out 2nd hand cloths, sorting out 2nd hand furniture or materials or books- helping into collecting the 2nd hand things in the people house (only strong volunteers can do that), selling the books/cloths/furniture to the public, tidying up the different little shops in the community- finally any mission useful for the well being of the community. Most of the companions have had hard times and harsh experiences. They are often tough people in appearance, who won t talk much at first. Volunteers should be mature, and aware of the difficulty of establishing communication with the companions and of gaining their confidence It is important to keep in mind that it is a social project, so that volunteers have to adapt their timetable to the one of the companions. Volunteers will have to be really motivated because it is a difficult work: they will work from Tuesday to Saturday from 7:30 am till 5:00 pm. Sunday and Mondays are free. Please note that although the project is close to Paris, you will have a limited time to visit the city, due to long working hours which cannot be bargained. If you do not agree with these conditions please do not apply.

To facilitate communication and integration, volunteers will take all their meals with the companions at the restaurant of the community. Volunteers will be hosted in basic conditions: they will sleep in a prefabricated building and share the shower and the toilets of the companions. The consumption of drugs and alcohol is strictly forbidden

Despite being small the area is a very popular tourist destination thanks to its natural beauty and vibrant culture. Restoring traditional architectural heritage (dovecotes, watermills, stone walls) and valuing the local rural landscape; Promoting traditional architecture, namely by providing training in traditional construction techniques; Re-

populating and maintaining traditional dovecotes; Sowing traditional agricultural varieties next to dovecotes to provide sustainable food for the doves; Identifying intangible heritage related to local nature and architectural heritage; Promoting environmental education activities especially designed for youngsters.

Info about the Camp (aims, tasks and activities – work, leisure and visits)

Uva lies in the surroundings of the International Douro Nature Park, with an impressive set of dovecotes: there are several of them, they take on various shapes, and they have an unquestionable unique heritage and architectural value. Furthermore, they are situated in an agriculturally and historically rich village which integrates the Special Protection Area of the International Douro Nature Park. This is where two dovecotes will be restored.

The main goals of this workcamp are to restore two traditional dovecotes, thus preserving architectural heritage and passing down traditional construction techniques; to enable the discovery of the Miranda Plateau, a unique rural region, rich in natural beauty, biodiversity, culture and traditions; and bringing together the young participants and the local community, therefore promoting intercultural (urban/rural, international/national) and intergenerational (youngsters/the elderly) encounters and exchanges.

The tasks planned for the dovecotes' restoration will be cleaning it on the inside, as well as its surroundings; removing the walls' original coating; restoring the rooftop; preparing the new limestone coating and whitewashing the outer walls.

As for leisure time, there are several activities planned for the participants to get to know the beautiful local landscapes, the rich cultural traditions and the local community: woodworking, helping villagers in their everyday tasks (watering the vegetable gardens, taking cattle to pasture, knitting, baking bread, etc.), trekking and hiking, bird watching, visiting the Miranda Donkey Breeding Centre, visiting the Algoso castle, visiting Vimioso and Miranda do Douro, introductory lesson on traditional music instruments (bagpipe, percussion), cinema nights, various games.
