Dejavato foundation

Who we are:

Dejavato foundation is non profit organization working for peace, international understanding and solidarity, education, social sustainable development and respect to the culture and environment through international voluntary work, educational and cultural activities as well as exploring natural attraction. Founded in 15 June 2005, Dejavato Foundation becomes fast growing NGO which organizes voluntary works in Europe, Asia as well as America. Around 50 projects of voluntary works were organized each year both national and international level.

What we do:

Workcamps are projects where a group of volunteers work and live together on a project which has been identified by a local community or a project working with that community. They are short term activities of between 2 to 3 weeks. Everybody can participate as the project includes support and training for the development of the activities. In only few cases the volunteers need to fulfil specific requirements and, if so, they are informed before applying. Workcamp activities can vary from renovating an old building to environmental education with children, from English teaching to construction work. Each project is organized within a local community and answer to specific requests while involving people from all over the world and promoting intercultural learning. Workcamps aim at bringing together people from different nationalities and promoting, through practical actions, mutual understanding and lasting peace. Workcamps are a practical tool to demonstrate that living working together and sharing knowledge is not only possible but rewarding.

Who we are:

IIBC of PKBI, was established in January 2000. Located in Semarang city, Central Java Indonesia. 400 km eastern Jakarta the capital. IIBC promotes and organizes IVS in Indonesia. Mainly organizes workcamp and LMTV. There are 6 full time staffs. IIBC believes that 'young generation is the agent of change toward world peace'.

What we do:

Short Term Volunteering is an international activity that deposits 2-3 weeks with special themes or purpose. Usually this activity is called "Workcamp"

Some of themes are: Children (Street Children, Children with Disabilities, Children in Slum Area, Children in Prostitution Area), Health And Reproduction Education, Education, Environment, Culture and Heritage, etc.
