SIW Internationale Vrijwilligersprojecten

Who we are?

SIW Internationale Vrijwilligersprojecten (SIW International Volunteer Projects) is a Dutch non-governmental, non-profit voluntary service organization that was founded in 1953.

Every year, SIW sends approximately 200 volunteers to foreign sister-organisations in Europe, North America, Asia, Latin America and Africa; in total about 120 organisations in more than 70 countries. These volunteers can choose between short term projects (2 to 4 weeks) in international groups and individual long term projects which last 2 to 12 months.

Besides that, every year SIW organises 10 to 15 international work camps in The Netherlands, most of them being held in July and August and lasting for two weeks. We organise these work camps in cooperation with Dutch social organisations like the Dutch State Forestry, Emmaus (international charitable movement to combat poverty and homelessness) and care institutions for elderly and handicapped people. Every year, SIW welcomes about 150 volunteers from all over the world.

What we do?

Every year SIW organises around 10 international voluntary projects in the Netherlands in cooperation with different Dutch social organisations. These projects take place in summer and take up to two weeks.

Projects are about environment, social activities and construction.
