The general objective of the project is to create awareness that the practice of sport is a human right for everyone without distinction of gender, origin, etc. Sport can be used to promote social inclusion and to combat racism and xenophobia or to promote gender equality.

- ✓ Discovering of mix-gendered sport
- ✓ Non formal education activities: Team building, role games, moving debates
- ✓ Playing and meeting with organizations which promote equality in sports and fight against discriminations
- ✓ Create a digital support to promote the fight against discrimination in sport (video, blog, etc.)
- ✓ Organize Equality Olympiads
- ✓ Visit of Paris

Profile of participants

Young European between 18 and 25 years old. Be aware of the topic of “sport and discrimination” and with an interest in it. Be interested in playing sports.

Accommodation and food

Accommodation and food will be provided.

The group will be hosted in Souppes-sur-Loing in a collective accommodation « La Villa des Sources » in dormitories of 4 or 6 people. Ideally located in an animal park, near a base of leisure. Souppes-sur-Loing is located one hour of transport from Paris in the Seine-et-Marne department at the southern edge of the Île-de-France region. The group will organize the breakfast, as well as the lunch and will have access to catering service for the dinner.

The idea of this youth exchange is to create a collective living setting, which means that the group will be shopping, cooking, washing dishes, and organizing the common living space all together as a group. At the beginning of the project, we will together create a system of sharing the living tasks equality within the group and you will have the possibility to cook your favorite dish!

Financial conditions:

Travel costs will be covered based on the unit costs of the program. Please note that participants will be reimbursed the real costs of their transport fees up to a certain limit as per information below.

Concordia would like to encourage participants to buy travel tickets ASAP to enjoy economical prices. Please do not buy travel tickets until your participation has been approved by Concordia. All the travel costs will be reimbursed the earliest 3 months after the end of the youth exchange. Please note that the process of reimbursement will be carried out directly with the applicant organizations and not with the individual participants.
