Who we are: Frères Agriculteurs et Artisans pour le Développement (FAGAD) is an organisation founded in 1990. Between 1986 and 1990, activities began as a farming group called Groupement Agricole Togolese against Hunger (GATOCOF). The idea of this organization is to bring together the producers and help them organize in order to improve their living conditions. This is the origin of Frères Agriculteurs et Artisans pour le Développement (FAGAD), an organization with multiple objectives and activities focused on development and cultural exchange.

<u>What we do:</u> Many young educated understood the need to provide support to the development of their communities or through their participation in community service, either through their participation in international youth work camps organized by FAGAD (construction of local public interest, cleaning rivers, reforestation -forestation, road construction, water supply, education and leisure children, supporting solar, sports, etc..)

Created in 1957, the NGO Togolese Association of Volunteers at Work (ASTOVOT) is one of the first Togolese associations. As a non-profit layman, ASTOVOT has been supporting international solidarity

initiatives for a number of decades, as well as the self-promotion of grassroots communities through local development projects. Today, it remains a great reference in terms of international volunteering and civic service in Togo.

What we do:

(ASTOVOT) is an association of International Volunteering and Local Development with the objective of:

- Contribute to the animation of the life by the participation of the Togolese and foreign volunteers to the realization of the works of general interest;

- Contribute to improving the living conditions of local populations by promoting their development and well

- being by safeguarding the ecological, socio-cultural, educational and health environment;
- Promote the movement of people and goods through international and intercultural exchanges;

For example, projects such as: socio-educational activities with mentally disabled young people or young deafmutes; peace education, environmental education, reforestation, assistantship at several schools (primary, secondary schools, high schools) of the city of Kpalimé and the villages of Agou; support to the health staff of the health centers of the city of Kpalimé; ecological and educational garden; Awareness campaigns on hygiene and STI / HIV / AIDS ...
