

PROJECT

The volunteer project takes place within the <u>Regional School of the First Degree Olympe Hériot</u>, in partnership with the Concordia association. It consists of opening up the school's pedagogical horizon thanks to interculturality and popular education methods. The volunteer will work with two volunteers

European students alongside the teaching team and supervisors of the ERPD Hériot in La Boissière-Ecole (78). ERPD Hériot has a <u>sea class centre</u> in <u>Cancale (Côte d'Armor)</u>. Two volunteers, one French and one European, will be welcomed on this site. The two teams of volunteers will work together to set up educational projects for the school's pupils. Volunteers working at La Boissière-École will be welcomed in Cancale from time to time as part of their assignment.

This mission requires dynamism, good interpersonal skills, a taste for teamwork and a sense of listening.

The volunteer will also be invited to take part in Concordia's associative life and will have the opportunity to meet other civic service volunteers.

MISSIONS

The aim of this project is to share your knowledge and learn how to develop educational project. In particular the activities will be:

- To contribute with the teaching staff in bringing an intercultural extent to their work.
- To be involved in the everyday life of the boarding school.
- To contribute with the teaching staff in developing new approaches and teaching methods.
- To assist individual and collective student's projects or any other non-formal educational project in fields chosen collectively according his her appetences (cooking / dance / heritage / digital / citizenship / healthcare / sustainable development / arts / career choices).

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ORGANISATION/LOGISTICS

Volunteers will be part of a team of 5 volunteers: 2 europeans and 1 french volunteers at La Boissière-Ecole, lle-de-France; and 1 european and 1 french volunteers in Cancale, Brittany. All the volunteers will form a team, sharing the same projects.


- The team of volunteers, accompanied by the educational teams will develop educational activities around sustainable development in connection with the countryside and the sea.
 Within the framework of this project, the volunteers hosted at La Boissière will be welcomed in Cancale on an occasional basis.
- All accommodation and travel expenses will be covered.

PRACTICAL CONDITIONS

Working Hours: The volunteer will work approx. 35 hours per week. They are entitled of 2 days-off per week, which will be mainly the weekends. They may be asked to work during some weekend due to some specifically planned activity,


Working and living conditions: Accommodation and food will be provided.


You will stay in the Olympe Hériot School with access to an individual house with two bedrooms (one for each European Volunteer), toilets, shower, kitchen and a living room. You will eat with the staff during the week and at the house during the weekends, and take shifts and spit the various chores (planning, cleaning, shopping, etc.). We will encourage the purchase of local and seasonal products.

RISKS AND CRISIS PREVENTION

In order to prevent any kind of crisis, Concordia Île-de-France believes that the info given during the preparation of the volunteers plays a very important role.

The detailed description of the activities, the possibilities for socializing, the accommodation and food and working conditions are very helpful for the volunteers in order to be orientated before their arrival.

The volunteer receives a detailed info pack before arrival and a welcome pack upon arrival where she/he can find useful call numbers and emergency numbers as well as info for his/her better integration to the local society.

The volunteer will participate in a monthly meeting in order to have the chance to talk about difficulties s/he is facing and find ways to overcome any possible issues occurred with Concordia member staff.

Once the volunteer arrives s/he attends a 1 day orientation session, where among other things s/he becomes aware of all the necessary instructions and measures for risk prevention for his safety in the house (house conditions, fire protection, use of electronic or gas devices etc), transport rules and habits, traveling, health prevention and local everyday life.

PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS

This project will be financed under <u>Service Civique</u> project, therefore each volunteer will get:

- Pocket money: 473,04€ / month
- Travel costs to and from Cancale will be covered
- The volunteer will be individually followed by a dedicated mentor.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

Travel costs to and from La Boissière Ecole are covered according to the Erasmus+ lump sums, based on the travel distance. Travel distances must be calculated using the distance calculator supported by the European Commission.

For travel distances between: 500 – 1999 km: 275 € per person 2000 – 2999 km: 360 € per person 3000 – 3999 km: 530 € per person
