Delegation of Ile de France - Concordia

Concordia is a French national non-governmental and non-profit making organization, founded in 1950 by English, German and French youngsters. Their aim was to enhance the values of tolerance and peace after the 2nd world war by organizing international workcamps of young volunteers.

The main objectives of Concordia are the following:

- Education in helping young people to grow up by acquisition of collective life.
- Culture in favoring the youth exchanges on an international level, always emphasizing the values of peace, friendship and mutual respect.
- Social in taking part in concrete actions of solidarity, as well as supporting a civic attitude
- Social economy contributes to realization of local development, in favor of the environment, patrimony, tourism and socio-educational animation.

Project environment

This CES project will take place in our office based in the 19th arrondissement of Paris. You'll be working mainly with 3 employees of the delegation. Many trips to Paris and the region will be expected

Task and activities

- 1. Promote the possibilities of the European projects' mobility, within the scope of volunteering, to the youth of the Ile-de-France region, in France and abroad.
- Assist with delivering the needed information in the Ile-de-France region via : Organizing meetings with the general public, communication through social media, developing and distributing the newsletter and proposing additional methods of communication.
- 2. Assist with the implementation of one or more international volunteering projects in Ile-de France:
- 3. Assist with the promotion and the design of non-formal education and popular education tools through: communication, creation of supporting documents, tools and the facilitation of workshops.
- 4. Assist with the creation of monthly trainings: including the preparation of popular education tools, assisting with the logistics and the design of the training schedule.
- 5. Assist with the development of partnerships: Following up with the external partners according to the training themes, as well as seeking new partnerships.



The volunteer's mission will take place in daily collaboration with the other international and French volunteers of the delegation of Ile-de-France, as well as between the volunteers and employees of the association.

Profile of participants

- Speak good English and/or French or to be motivated to learn French;
- > Ability to work and cooperate in a team
- > Be flexible, autonomous and open to meet with new people, to think outside of the box
- > Public speaking skills
- Be willing to develop a personal project
- Motivation to discover the associative world and all its activities

Practical conditions

Activity period: From 3 January 2022 to 3 June 2022

Working Hours: The volunteer will work approx. **24 hours per week**. They are entitled to 3 days-off per week, which will be mainly the weekends and a day to be agreed upon. They may be asked to work during some weekends due to some specifically planned activity. Working from home could be expected for some days in the week.

Working and living conditions: Accommodation and food will be provided.

You will be staying in "Maison des Volontaires" in the 13th arrondissement, with access to an individual studio with a toilet, shower, and kitchen. You will eat with the staff during the working days and at the house during the weekends and the days-off. We will encourage the purchase of local and seasonal products.
