### What is SPORTUNION?

SPORTUNION is an Austrian national sports-for-all umbrella organization with more than 670.000 members in more than 4.400 sports clubs in Austria. Our mission is to support our members to provide access to and inclusion in sports and health-enhancing activities to members of society. We believe in conveying ethical values and tolerance through sports and cultural activities. Values such as fair play, intercultural understanding, a moral tenor towards ethical correctness in sports, teamwork and personal development through sports are central themes which we address. Our headquarter is located right in the city centre of Vienna. The administrative office of FICEP (Fédération Internationale Catholique d'Education Physique et sportive) is located in the SPORTUNION headquarter in Vienna. We want to share our experiences and knowledge in the field of sports especially on national level. We are interested in new ideas which you may bring to our organization.

### Proposed activities

As a volunteer, you will work mainly at the SPORTUNION headquarter and you will be involved in the following fields and activities:

- 60% administrative tasks (e.g. working with database, website etc.)
- 30% event management (e.g. planning and implementation in the field of youth sports)
- 10% practical work (e.g. participation in trainings, guiding groups etc.)

Your working days will be from Monday to Thursday. Working days can be changed if necessary. You will work about 30 hours per week.

**You will get the opportunity:**

- to work in the organizational field of sports
- to be part of our team and bring in your own ideas
- to get an idea on how to plan education and training on national level
- to participate in team meetings and events on local, national and international level
- to learn and improve German

**Volunteer profile**

We are looking for applicants from all ESC program and partner countries aged between 18 and 30 years for the period from March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 to February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2023. In general, you should be motivated to work in the organizational field of sports. We are looking for open-minded young women and men. The working language is mostly German. Basic knowledge of English is beneficial. Before you start, no language skills are required. You will be invited to attend a German course during your project. A general interest in sports would be great.
