PROJECT DESCRIPTION

METHODOLOGY:

The whole project will be based on non-formal education - NFE methodologies. It will be proposed a learning by doing approach, where each activity is based on specific learning objectives in order to better target the educational action and to ensure a coherent learning process of individuals and groups.

PIRATES is an Advanced Training for Trainers - AT4Ts, conceived to boost trainers' capacities, to share, test and upgrade methodologies and approaches in non-formal education. Therefore, trainers and facilitators involved will actively participate in developing most of the TC sessions, in a horizontal way, being in the same time, facilitators and participants.

AIM:

To develop tools and working methods, among facilitators and trainers, to further promote the active participation of young people and those more at risk of exclusion.

More specifically, the Advanced Training for Trainers, foresees to exchange knowledge and resources among trainers involved in activities at European, national and local levels, by further supporting the exchange of practises, approaches and peer learning.

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TRAVEL COSTS AND REFUNDS
