AIM

To develop tools and working methods, among youth workers, educators and group leaders, to promote sustainability among young people, using non formal education techniques.

OBJECTIVES

- to develop social competences and skills to be facilitators and youth leaders
- to explore the issues of violence, conflict management and peace building
- to experiment methods and tools for peace-building and conflict management to be proposed to young people

ACCOMMODATION

LA BUONA TERRA is located in a marvellous farm in the countryside, surrounded by nature.

It is composed by: dormitory with bunk beds, a multi-purposed room and an outdoor space for workshops, shared toilets and showers, a professional kitchen, and a dining room for free time and meals. It will be prepared and served by our kitchen staff.

The venue is managed by following sustainable practices (such as garbage recycling, responsible water and electricity use, etc.) and participants will be invited to follow these ones.

Participants will be involved in the **daily maintenance tasks**: cleaning of the common spaces and support in the kitchen management (cleaning dishes, set the tables, etc.).



INSURANCE

Lunaria provides insurance during the project period for civil liability (only for possible accident in project activities or those caused by participants).

Participants are strongly recommended to bring their own Health Insurance Card if they have one and to take a travel insurance.

However, participants are not insured for personal belongings, and neither the host nor Lunaria can be held responsible for these during the project.



The refund of the travel costs is only possible if participants travel from and return to the country of their sending organisation.

In order to be as sustainable as possible, Lunaria invites participants to choose the **greenest travel option** possible (e.g. carpooling, train, bus). Please, check the budget available in the table below.

Participants' travel costs

will be refunded only upon the presentation of all the original travel documents (paper and online).

Normally the refund process can take, approximately, 4-6 months.

The travel costs are refunded according to the Travel Distance Calculator of the EACEA (table below).

Concerning standard travel: the maximum travel days are 1 extra day before the arrival day and 1 extra day after the departure day. Therefore, for example regarding SUNRISE TC: a participant can start their travel to Italy on the 3th February and arrive at the venue on the 4th February, and can leave the venue on the 12th February and arrive back home on the 13th February.

The participants cannot start their travel earlier and cannot arrive back home later.

Concerning green travel (bus, trains, carpooling), there is the possibility to have up to 4 travel days to combine however the participant needs (without including the arrival and departure days).
