- to gain a deeper knowledge about different approaches in the work with teenagers
- to deepen the group dynamics, rhythms and functioning
- to develop, test and assess methods and tools to promote inclusive approaches

# IMPORTANT REMARKS

The project is structured in a chronological perspective. Therefore, in order to ensure the continuity of the methods and topics covered, some of the participants in the training course will be involved as follows:

- The **training course** will be an intensive training experience to develop social competences and skills as facilitators and youth leaders.
- The **APV** (a preparatory visit targeted to the training course participants selected to be group leaders) will contribute to build the program of activities to be proposed during the youth exchanges. Two coordinators will facilitate the process.
- The **youth exchanges** will involve teenagers (**aged between 15-17**) from the different partner countries. The group leaders will be in charge of the activities program and the delivering of some workshops. They will be supported by two coordinators throughout the youth exchanges exchange.



## ABOUT THE TARGET OF TC:

The training programme will include information on how to deal with certain situations and will be based on the experiences of workcamps and international youth exchanges.

Therefore having previous experience in education field with teenagers is more than welcome.

Or previous experience in workcamps and youth exchanges **as participant** (not leader) is more than welcome.



## ABOUT THE PROGRAM OF TC:

The program of the TC includes **two main intensive workshop sessions**, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

## ACCOMMODATION

**LA BUONA TERRA** is a marvellous farm in the countryside, located on a hillside surrounded by nature and close to the Trasimeno's lake.

The venue is composed by: dormitory with bunk beds, a multi-purposed room and an outdoor space for workshops, shared toilets and showers, a professional kitchen, and a dining room for free time and meals. All the meals will be prepared and served by our kitchen staff.

The venue is managed by following sustainable practices (such as garbage recycling, responsible consume of water and electricity, etc.) and **participants will be invited to follow these ones.**

Participants will be involved in the **daily maintenance tasks**: cleaning of the common spaces and support in the kitchen management (cleaning dishes, set the tables, etc.).

## INSURANCE

Lunaria provides insurance during the project period for civil liability (only for possible accident in project activities or those caused by participants).

Participants are strongly recommended to bring their own Health Insurance Card if they have one and to take a travel insurance.

# FINANCIAL CONDITION

The refund of the travel costs is only possible if participants travel from and return to the country of their sending organisation.

In order to be as sustainable as possible, Lunaria invites participants to choose the **greenest travel option** possible (e.g. carpooling, train, bus). Please, check the budget available in the table below.

Participants' travel costs will be refunded only upon the **presentation of all the original travel documents (paper and online).**

Normally the refund process can take, approximately, **4-6 months.**
