AIM

To develop skills and competences to work with teenagers, promoting anti-discriminatory approaches among young people.

OBJECTIVES

- to develop social competences and skills as facilitators and youth leaders
- to gain a deeper knowledge about different approaches in the work with teenagers
- to deepen the group dynamics, rhythms and functioning
- to develop, test and assess methods and tools to promote inclusive approaches

Active volunteers, activists, youth workers and facilitators (18+ aged) with previous experience in leading group of young people.

IMPORTANT REMARKS

The project is structured in a chronological perspective. Therefore, in order to ensure the continuity of the methods and topics covered, some of the participants in the training course will be involved as follows:

The **training course** will be an intensive training experience to develop social competences and skills as facilitators and youth leaders.

The **APV** (a preparatory visit targeted to the training course participants selected to be group leaders) will contribute to build the program of activities to be proposed during the youth exchanges. Two coordinators will facilitate the process.

The **youth exchanges** will involve teenagers (aged between 15-17) from the different partner countries. The group leaders will be in charge of the activities program and the delivering of some workshops. They will be supported by two coordinators throughout the youth exchanges exchange.



ABOUT THE TARGET OF TC:

The training program will be an opportunity to experiment and develop non formal education tools and approaches on how to work with teenagers. Therefore having previous experiences in activities targeted to teenagers or experiences in workcamps and youth exchanges is more than welcome.



ABOUT THE PROGRAM OF TC:

The program of the TC includes **two main intensive workshop sessions**, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

ACCOMMODATION

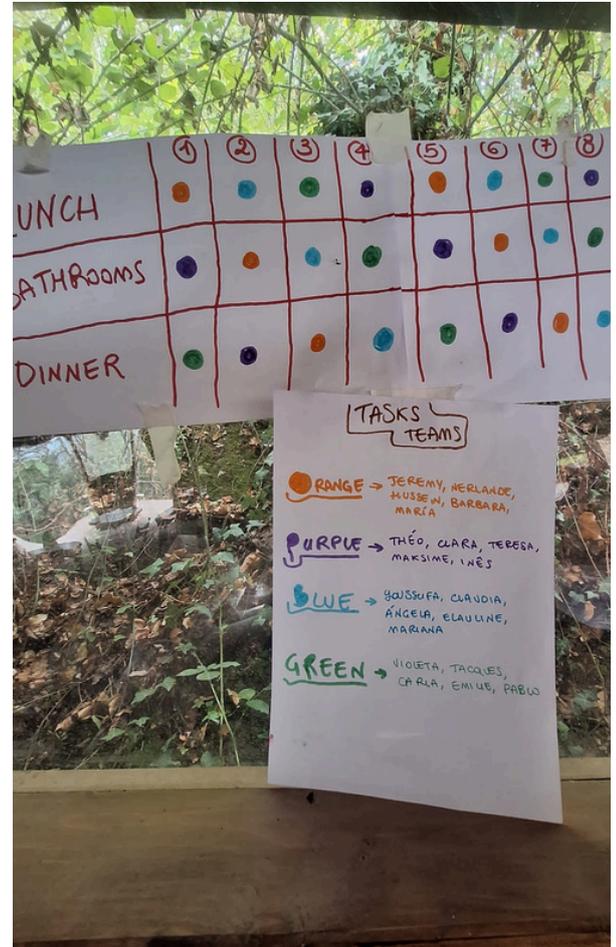
La **Buona Terra** is located in a marvellous farm in the countryside, surrounded by nature.

It is composed of: dormitory with bunk beds, a multi-purposed room and an outdoor space for workshops, shared toilets and showers, a professional kitchen, and a dining room for free time and meals. It will be prepared and served by our kitchen staff.

We kindly remind everybody to inform us on scambi@lunaria.org about any specific needs concerning food or allergies.

The venue is managed by following sustainable practices (such as garbage recycling, responsible water and electricity use, etc.) and participants will be invited to follow these ones. Participants will be involved in the **daily maintenance** tasks: cleaning of the common spaces and support in the kitchen management (cleaning dishes, setting the tables, etc.).

Due to the sometimes unpredictable **water shortage in Italy**, some water cuts may occur in the hosting facilities. In case of water cut, the use of the water in the hosting structure (for showers, toilets) could be rearranged. For the whole duration of the project, drinkable water will always be guaranteed.

INSURANCE

Lunaria provides insurance during the project period for civil liability (only for possible accidents in project activities or those caused by participants).

Participants are strongly recommended to bring their own Health Insurance Card if they have one and to take travel insurance.

However, participants are not insured for personal belongings, and neither the host nor Lunaria can be held responsible for these during the project.

FINANCIAL CONDITION

The refund of the travel costs is only possible if participants travel from and return to the country of their sending organisation.

In order to be as sustainable as possible, Lunaria invites participants to choose the **greenest travel option** possible (e.g. carpooling, train, bus). Please, check the budget available in the table below.

Participants' travel costs will be refunded only upon the **presentation of all the original travel documents (paper and online).**

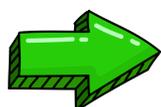
Normally the refund process can take, approximately, **4-6 months.**

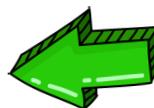


FOR THE OFFICIAL ARRIVAL DAY

(Central European Time).



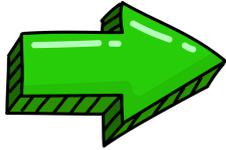
IMPORTANT NOTE: Only for participants who choose the Green Travel option have 4 days of flexibility (arrival and departure days not included) to travel to the venue. They can manage in the most suitable way for them (e.g. 2 extra days before the official arrival + 2 extra days after the official departure day; 1 extra day before the arrival, 3 extra days after the departure day). Participants will be reimbursed for the accommodation costs incurred during the Green travel, within the budget shown above and only presenting the original receipts of the costs.
